

# DIR Public Works Contractor Registration



March 1, 2015 – Contractors must be registered for submitting Bid Proposals

April 1, 2015 – Contractors must be registered to be awarded a public works construction project.

January 1, 2016 – Contractors must be registered to work on a public works construction project, regardless of when it was bid and/or awarded. And Contractors will be required to submit certified payrolls on-line to the Labor Commissioners.

Registration is good for fiscal year through June 30, 2015; renewal annually.

FAQ:

Q. How do you know if your company is required to register?

A. All work that is mandated to pay prevailing wage requires Contractors be registered.

Q. What are the minimum requirements?

A. Have a valid Contractors License; Proof of workers compensation insurance; No outstanding issues with the state for wage penalties; Good standing with no debarment from performing PW projects.

Q. What if a Contractor fails to register?

A. Ineligible to bid on PW projects; Ineligible to work on PW projects; 1<sup>st</sup> year violation in a 12-month period may be required to pay \$2,000 fine; Inadvertent lapsed renewal, 90day grace period.
