



The Wheatland School District was established in 1871, when the former Bear River School District was divided into Virginia and Wheatland School Districts.

The town of Wheatland is valued by its residents for its small town atmosphere and rural setting. Located in Northern California's Central Valley along State Route 65 in Yuba County, Wheatland is approximately one mile north of the Bear River and the tri-county boundary of Sutter, Placer, and Yuba Counties and 40 miles north of Sacramento. Beale Air Force Base is located eight miles to the northeast, and many students from the base's military families attend Wheatland School District schools.
