- 2.1 Superintendent Update Craig Guensler
- Superintendent Guensler sent everyone an email that California was dropping the student vaccine mandate. The Governor will not seek the executive power for a mandate at this time. The earliest we could see anything would be for the 2023-24 school year.
- Testing unvaccinated employees has not changed, so we will continue to test through the rest of the school year.
- We have had zero positive COVID tests this week. It's a little surprising coming after Spring Break, but it's a great sign.
- Staff salary increased as all negotiations are completed. This month employees will receive the retro pay. Next month employees will receive the stipend.
- ➤ We are looking and advertising for staff for the 2022-23 school year. We need 3 special education teachers and at least one in the charter.
- ➢ 8th Grade Promotion is scheduled for Friday, June 10 at 10:00 a.m. The dance will be an off-site event run by parents. It will not be school sponsored.
- Summer camp will be held from June 13th through June 30th. It will be held Monday through Thursday from 7:45 until 2:15 at Lone Tree School on Beale AFB. No camp on Fridays. Student must be currently enrolled in the District from Tk-8th. Priority will be given to students who qualify under the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act and Foster Youth. Summer Camp is free to all students. Open Enrollment is from April 27th to May 20th. Transportation will be provided from Wheatland to the base.

2.2 Enrollment Report

- We have 1305 students. This is 40 students more than we had last year at this time and 8 fewer than we had last month.
- We have 142 students in the preschool classes which is 30 more than last year and the same as last month.
