

Quarantine/Isolation Scenarios and Steps for Students/Staff

STUDENT SCENARIOS

<u>Scenarios</u>	<u>Quarantine/Isolation Rules</u>
<u>Student is COVID Positive</u>	<p><i>All Students:</i> The student can reduce the number of days they must isolate (regardless of vaccination status) from 10 days to 5 days if all the following are TRUE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 24-hours have passed since the resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; AND • The student takes or provides WSD with a COVID-19 test (antigen recommended) on or after Day 5 and it comes back <u>NEGATIVE</u>; AND • They continue to wear a well-fitting mask while at school. (Mask exemption still apply)
<u>Student is Symptomatic (regardless of vaccination status)</u>	<p><i>All Students:</i> Students may return to school if <u>all three criteria</u> below are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 24-hours have passed since the resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; and • Other symptoms have improved; and • Individual has a District Supervised negative COVID-19 test or parent attests to an at-home test, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>OR</i> a healthcare provider has provided documentation that the symptoms are typical of their underlying chronic condition (e.g. allergies, asthma, etc.), • <i>OR</i> a healthcare provider has confirmed an alternative named diagnosis, • <i>OR</i> at least 10-days have passed since symptom onset. <p><i>*If student becomes positive, follow the positive protocol above.</i></p>
<u>Student is Asymptomatic and Exposed at Home</u>	<p><i>Vaccinated/Or Confirmed Positive COVID within last 90 days (from symptom onset):</i> If all of the following are true, the student may remain at school and continue participating in extracurricular activities (e.g., sports, clubs, etc.). They are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fully vaccinated or Confirmed Positive in the last 90 days; • Have shared their vaccination card with school staff for verification or shared the registered positive test results; and • Remain free of COVID-19 like symptoms (asymptomatic).

<p><u>(cont) Student is Asymptomatic and Exposed at Home</u></p>	<p><i>Unvaccinated or Undetermined Status:</i> Students are not required to quarantine and may continue coming to school if all the following are TRUE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A negative COVID test is obtained immediately upon the district knowing of the home positive case: • A negative COVID test is obtained on day 3 after the first test: and • A negative COVID test is obtained on day 5 after the first test: and • Student wears a well-fitting mask around others: and • Student continues to have no symptoms <p><i>Unvaccinated or Undetermined Status that are asymptomatic and <u>who chooses to not test:</u></i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Student who do not test must quarantine for 10 days after the last exposure with the positive case. If the positive person is living in the student’s household the last exposure is determined by either 10 days after the positive person’s symptoms began or 5 days after the symptoms began with a negative COVID test.</u>
<p>Student is Asymptomatic and Exposed at School</p>	<p><i>All Students:</i> Students are not required to quarantine and may continue coming to school if all the following are TRUE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remains Symptom Free: and • Student wears a well-fitting mask around others; and • Student will need to be tested if symptoms arise

STAFF SCENARIOS	
<u>Scenarios</u>	<u>Quarantine/Isolation Rules</u>
<u>Staff is Positive</u>	<p>Staff can reduce the number of days they must isolate (regardless of vaccination status) from 10 days to 5 days if all the following are TRUE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 24-hours have passed since the resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications; AND • The staff member takes and/or provides WSD with a COVID-19 test (antigen recommended) on or after Day 5 and it comes back <u>NEGATIVE</u>; AND • They continue to wear a well-fitting mask while at school.
<u>Staff is Symptomatic</u> <u>(regardless of vaccination status)</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff should not come to school and should isolate themselves at home. • Staff may return to work when the following steps are completed and true: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No fever without fever-reducing medication for 24 hours; <i>and</i> ○ Symptoms improving; <i>and</i> ○ One of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Provide WSD with a District supervised or attestation accompanying an at-home Negative COVID-19 test; OR ▪ A healthcare provider has provided documentation that the symptoms are typical of their underlying chronic condition (e.g., allergies or asthma); OR ▪ A healthcare provider has confirmed an alternative named diagnosis; OR ▪ At least 10 days have passed since symptom onset. <p><i>*If staff becomes positive, follow positive protocol below.</i></p>
<u>Staff is Asymptomatic and Exposed at home</u>	<p><i>Vaccinated/Or Confirmed Positive COVID within last 90 days (from symptom onset):</i> If all of the following are true, the staff may remain at work. They are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fully vaccinated or Confirmed Positive in the last 90 days; • Have shared their vaccination card with school staff for verification or shared the registered positive test results; and • Remain free of COVID-19 like symptoms (asymptomatic). <p><i>Unvaccinated or Undetermined Status:</i> Staff are not required to quarantine and may continue coming to work if all the following are TRUE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No longer exposed to positive case

<p>Staff is Asymptomatic and Exposed at home</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A negative diagnostic test is obtained within 3-5 days after last exposure to a case; and • Staff wears a well-fitting mask around others; and • Staff continues to have no symptoms. <p><i>*Staff testing on a weekly basis will suffice for testing requirements.</i></p>
<p>Staff is Asymptomatic and Exposed at work</p>	<p>Regardless of vaccination status, staff asymptomatic and exposed at work are not required to quarantine and may continue coming to work if all the following are TRUE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Vaccinated staff may choose to use, but not required, the WSD testing program 3-5 days after last exposure. • Unvaccinated staff will be tested 3-5 days after last exposure and will continue to test as part of the weekly testing and may request a second weekly test after the exposure; and • Staff wears a well-fitting mask around others; and • Staff continues to have no symptoms
