This series includes one-on-one parent consultation so you can get answers to your questions on applying these 12 Whole-Brain Child Strategies to your child's unique needs.

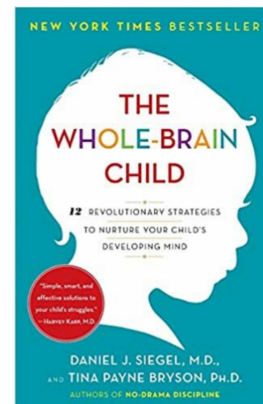
