2. REPORTS AND COMMUNICATION

2.1 Superintendent’s Update – Craig Guensler

- All the sites have done a good job of monitoring the heat and smoke this week. Each campus allowed students who didn’t want to go outside to remain in cool rooms. The after school classes were held indoors this week.
- The Bus Grant will cover \$165,000.00 to replace bus #8. The grant doesn’t cover air conditioning, but the District will pay for that.
- The bill for property casualty premium has increased to \$443,373.00 which is a difference of \$135,000.00 more than last year.
- We are still seeing plenty of cases of COVID. It is affecting the sub pool, but the schools are managing.
- The City applied for a grant for a community pool, but they were not successful. They’ll look for other options.
- The 2 x 2 x 2 (2 board members from here and the high school and 2 city managers) met. The Caliterra Ranch is slated for 552 single family units and have already sold some of the homes. It will likely be January that people start to move in. The First Street Senior Housing will have 30 units in phase I and 20 in phase II. That project will come after the Bear Ridge Apartment Complex is finished. These are 48 multi-family low income units off Spenceville Road.

We had 1366 students at the time of this report. That is 2 less than last year and 6 less than August. There are 117 in preschool. That's 25 fewer than last year and 9 more than last month.
